


Living in the Kingdom

The Ideal Outcome

² Out of the most severe trial, their overflowing joy and their extreme poverty welled up in rich generosity. 3 For I testify that they [Macedonian churches] gave as much as they were able, and even beyond their ability. The Macedonian Example


"The willingness to sacrifice on the part of the Macedonian believers came as a result of wholehearted consecration. Moved by the Spirit of God, they 'first gave their own selves to the Lord' (2) Cor. 8:5); then they were willing to give freely of their means for the support of the gospel. It was not necessary to urge them to give; rather, they rejoiced in the privilege of denying themselves even of necessary things in order to supply the needs of others." (Ellen G. White, Acts of the Apostles, p.343.2)

Fundamental of Stewardship

Christian stewardship and generosity starts with the giving of one's total self, first, to God




Surface Level

LIFE WITHOUT JESUS CHRIST




Christ Transformation



"It is the grace of Christ alone, through faith, that can make us holy." (Ellen G. White, Steps to Christ, p. 59.4)


