Stewardship #21

We are God's stewards, entrusted by Him with time and opportunities, abilities and possessions, and the blessings of the earth and its resources. We are responsible to Him for their proper use. We acknowledge God's ownership by faithful service to Him and our fellow human beings, and by returning tithe and giving offerings for the proclamation of His gospel and the support and growth of His church. Stewardship is a privilege given to us by God for nurture in love and the victory over selfishness and covetousness. Stewards rejoice in the blessings that come to others as a result of their faithfulness.

"we are God's stewards"

3. Stewardship is wholistic – includes all

"entrusted with time, opportunities, abilities, possessions, blessings, resources"

4. Stewardship includes Tithe & Offerings

"returning tithe and giving offerings"

5. Stewardship is missional – privilege

"blessings that come to others"



The FAMILY (the human family and society) established by God (Genesis 1:27; 2:24) 4. MATERIAL RESOURCES (including finances) that belong to God (Genesis 1:1,28) 5. TIME (including the Sabbath) appointed with God (Genesis 2:1-3)

Leviticus 27:30-33 (NIV)

¹⁸ "If any of you presents a gift for a burnt offering to the LORD, either to fulfill a vow or as a freewill offering, ¹⁹ you must present a male without defect from the cattle, sheep or goats in order that it may be accepted on your behalf. ²⁰ Do not bring anything with a defect, because it will not be accepted on your behalf." Lev 22:18-20 (NIV)

Unacceptable Offerings

"Oh, that one of you would shut the temple doors, so that you would not light useless fires on my altar! I am not pleased with you," says the Lord Almighty, "and I will accept no offering from your hands." *Malachi 1:10 (NIV)*

¹³ "When you bring injured, lame or diseased animals and offer them as sacrifices, should I accept them from your hands?" says the Lord. ¹⁴"Cursed is the cheat who has an acceptable male in his flock and vows to give it, but then sacrifices a blemished animal to the Lord." *Malachi 1:13,14 (NIV)*

- 1. Giving that recognizes that God is first
- 2. Giving of our total self to God
- 3. Response of <mark>love</mark> to God's saving grace
- 4. Expression of faith and total trust in God
- 5. Voluntary act from a grateful heart
- 6. Commitment to the mission and ministry of God
- 7. Outflow of right relationship with God & neighbour
- 8. Giving is spontaneous, systematic and sacrificial
