

2025 - 2026 V1 VERIFICATION WORKSHEET

Your application was selected, by the Federal Government, for review in a process called "Verification." In this process, Southern will be comparing information from your application with copies of your 2023 Federal tax return transcripts, or with W-2 forms or other financial documents. If you are a dependent student we will also ask for your parents 2023 Federal Tax information.

The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT) that is part of the FAFSA on the Web at FAFSA.gov. If there are differences between your application information and your financial documents, Southern may need to make electronic corrections.

What you should do

- 1. If you did not use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool on your FAFSA, you must submit a 2023 tax return transcript from the IRS, or a signed copy of your 1040.
- 2. Complete and sign the worksheet. A parent signature is needed for dependent students.
- 3. Submit the completed worksheet, tax forms, and any other documents your school requests to your financial aid administrator.
- 4. Talk to your financial aid administrator if you have any questions about completing this worksheet.
